<u>Sauvignon Blanc</u> , Larrick Vineyard Dry Creek Valley 2009 Floral honey suckle, lime water and pomelo. Bright acidity with a citrus pop and tropical finish. 292 cases produced.	\$22.00	\$17.60

Cinnamon spice & sesame nose with round flavors of apple pie & toasted crust. Drinking well now and through 2012. Only 247 cases produced.</p>	\$28.00	\$22.40
