VINEYARDS / WINEMAKING:

From two small, family-owned vineyards in Dry Creek Valley, one by Lake Sonoma in the northern Dry Creek Valley and one on the southwestern bench off West Dry Creek Road. Crafted with a light touch in the style of Pinot Noir production. This wine goes through a whole berry fermentation on native yeast and ages “sur lie” in French oak (17% new) for 16 months.

TASTING NOTES:

Dark purple in color. At first it displays earthy, dusty, cocoa tones that give way to cassis, plum, and hints of sassafras, graphite and licorice. Notes of charred oak with cedar and caramel tones add further complexity. Brimming with dark fruits on the palate, the tannins are finely integrated with a slight chalkiness. Sappy cassis, black currants, and plum flavors stick to the palate yet the wine maintains balance with a sense of coolness. Quite refined in its power, fruit abounds with creamy richness and tangy acidity in the lengthy finish.
