TASTING NOTES:

This vintage is consistent with prior bottlings in exhibiting what we call the good “Pinot funk” with aromas of earth, leather and wet clay balanced with black cherry and baking spices. Very full and juicy mouthfeel of red and black fruit with a hint of jalepeño and a long lingering finish. Drink now thru 2026.
