This 4.5 acre vineyard of Pinot Noir sits on a beautiful south-facing slope of Gold Ridge soil in the Middle Reach neighborhood of the Russian River Valley and is tended sustainably by Rick Moshin and grower/partner Richard Milkovich. The clonal selection is a mix of Calera and Pommard.

TASTING NOTES:

Building from a lean, nervy edge of brambly black fruit with a gently spicy nose of cinnamon, this powerful, expressive wine evolves to a wild-toned spectrum of ripe cherry, iron-laced earth, rich game, fresh violets, and black tea. This beauty blooms to its full, fruit-forward potential within 20-30 minutes of decanting, and makes your mouth water. Drink now through 2030.
