VINEYARDS / WINEMAKING:

This 4.5 acre vineyard of Pinot Noir sits on a beautiful south-facing slope of Gold Ridge soil in the Middle Reach neighborhood of the Russian River Valley and is tended sustainably by Rick Moshin. The clonal selection is a mix of Calera and Pommard. The wine is open top fermented then barrel aged in 33% new French oak for 11 months.

TASTING NOTES:

A sunny and bright Pinot Noir exhibiting elegant and nuanced old-world style. Aromas and flavors of cherry, rose petals, rich stone fruit of black and red plum with hints of baking spices and toast. Cool and silky on the palate, evolving nicely with aeration. Well structured for cellaring, drink now through 2023.
