Grapes for this Rosé of Pinot Noir are sourced from premium vineyards in the Russian River Valley in Sonoma County, California. Captured “free run” juice delivers the essence and purity of the grape while a percentage of pressed juice adds structure and complexity. This vintage is predominately Estate-grown Pinot Noir that was harvested early to avoid contact with accumulating smoky conditions - resulting in a smaller production for the 2020 vintage.

TASTING NOTES:

Aromas and flavors of bright red fruits; strawberry, cherry, watermelon and hints of grapefruit with a tinge of savoriness. The finish is clean and fresh - the perfect balance of succulent fruit and mouthwatering acidity. Drink now through 2023.
