### APPELLATION:

Russian River Valley, Sonoma County, California

### VINEYARDS / WINEMAKING:

Our Chardonnay is created from local vineyards within the Russian River Valley appellation in close proximity to our historic Wohler Bridge. Using native yeast, we fermented and aged the wine in oak barrels (10% new) sur lies for nine months. This wine went thru 100% malolactic fermentation.

### TASTING NOTES:

A very balanced Chardonnay with flavors and aromas of lemon curd, pineapple, gardenia, sesame and star fruit. Very subtle oak influence and creaminess with a bright and balanced tropical finish. Classic varietal character with a light touch - this lovely white wine is a crowd pleaser!
