Inviting bright pale straw color and delicate bubbles. Pretty perfume of golden raspberry, crisp pears, and hints of brioche. Attractive dry mouthfeel with bright flavors of Queen Anne cherry, apple and delicate rose petals. Beautiful balance of texture - very refined with a clean finish.
