Native yeast and open tank fermentation methods contribute to the layered flavors and aromas. Aged 11 months in 15% new French oak.

TASTING NOTES:

This blend of select barrels represents a variety of Pinot Noir vineyards and clones. Aromas of red fruits, wet earth and toasty oak are followed by lush, ripe flavors of dark cherries, plums, and baking spice. Balanced depth is highlighted by bright acidity, making this a versatile choice for your dining table.
