This Pinot Noir is sourced from our 20 acres of Estate vineyards located in the Middle Reach neighborhood of the Russian River Valley. The clonal selections (Calera, Swan, Wädenswil, Pommard, Martini, Dijon 115 and 777) are winemaker tended and sustainably farmed.

TASTING NOTES:

This is an inviting blend representing all four of our Estate Pinot Noir vineyards. Classic Russian River aromas and flavors with hints of toasty almonds, coffee, and cherry pie. Silky texture moving through red and black fruit flavors on the tongue, lightly spiced on the palate finishing with a firm tannin structure. Drink now through 2028.
